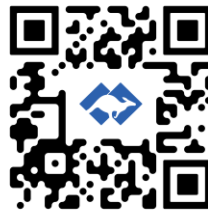

Council commits to help implement some improvements to the Memorial Reserve outlined in the Community Plan

The Millgrove Community Plan 2025-2030 was presented to Council in August and was wholeheartedly accepted. Infrastructure immediately identified some areas that they could get involved with and visited Millgrove on site soon after. We are most grateful for the support that Cr Jim Child and Council provide to us and as a result of our discussions, we hope to see some significant improvements, including sealing the of the reserve road, lighting on both sides of the toilet block, bollards along the Warburton Hwy reserve boundary, external powerpoints for the market and events and improvements to the small roadway island at the shops.
