MILLWARRA PRIMARY SCHOOL PRINCIPAL AND MILLGROVE RESIDENT ACTION GROUP MEET TO DISCUSS RESILIENCE

Maureen, Jan & Phil from MRAG and Michael Goodrich from Yarra Ranges Council met with Melanie Hancock, the new Principal at Millwarra Primary School, firstly to welcome her back to the community and secondly to discuss an ongoing partnership with the school to help build a resilient Millgrove.

Melanie said that “the school is coincidently focusing on several key pillars for pupil personal development, one is resilience”. This compliments the recently released Millgrove Community Plan, a more resilient Millgrove and the recent \$277,000 resilience grant provided by AusNet to install solar panels and batteries at the Community Hall.

Phil stated that “this is an essential first stage in setting up a planned Community Resilient Emergency Hub for the township as outlined in the Community Plan and is an important development for both the school and the community.”

Maureen said that “MRAG is looking forward to future events that share the school facilities, such as the Dinner on the Green planned for 7th March and Light Trail Event 2025 planned for 12th April.”

All parties are very keen to have regular meetings to ensure that any complementary opportunities are exploited to their full potential for the benefit of all.
